Пояснительная записка

Олимпиада по английскому языку проводится в целях выявления и развития у обучающихсятворческихспособностейиинтересакнаучной (научно-исследовательской) деятельности, пропаганды научных знаний.

Задачиолимпиады:

- популяризация английского языка и культур англоязычных стран в Российской Федерации;
- выявление школьников, проявляющих интерес к изучению английского языка и культуранглоязычных стран.

Рабочим языком проведения олимпиады является русский язык.

Участие в олимпиаде индивидуальное, олимпиадные задания выполняются участником самостоятельно, без помощи посторонних лиц.

Форма проведения олимпиады – очная.

Школьный этап олимпиады проводится по заданиям, разработанным для 5-11 классов, муниципальный — для 7-11 классов. Участник каждого этапа олимпиады выполняет олимпиадные задания, разработанные для класса, программу которого он осваивает, или для более старших классов. В случае прохождения участников, выполнивших задания, разработанные для более старших классов по отношению к тем, программы которых они осваивают, на следующий этап олимпиады, указанные участники и на следующих этапах олимпиады выполняют олимпиадные задания, разработанные для класса, который они выбрали на предыдущем этапе олимпиады, или более старших классов.

Возрастные группы:

возрастная группа (5-6 классы) - время проведения — 45 минут возрастная группа (7-8 классы) - время проведения — 60 минут возрастная группа (9 -11 классы) - время проведения — 120 минут

- В комплект олимпиадных заданий письменного тура олимпиады по каждой возрастной группе (классу) входят:
 - бланк заданий (Приложение 1);
 - аудиозапись для конкурса понимания устной речи;
 - бланк ответов (Приложение 2);
 - критерии и методика оценивания выполненных олимпиадных заданий (Приложение 3).

Олимпиадные задания для школьного этапа имеют разный уровень сложности:

- для 5- 6классов—уровень сложности по шкале Совета Европы Al-A2;
- для 7-8 классов—уровень сложности по шкале Совета Европы А2-В1;
- для 9-11 классов—уровень сложности по шкале Совета Европы В1-В2.

Школьный этап олимпиады проводится по четырем конкурсам:

- понимание устной речи (Listening);
- понимание письменной речи (Reading);
- лексико-грамматический тест (Useof English);
- письменная речь (Writing).

Для возрастной группы 5-6 классов конкурс устной речи (Speaking).

Участникам не разрешается брать в аудиторию бумагу, справочные материалы (словари, справочники, учебники и т. д.), мобильные телефоны, диктофоны, плейеры, планшеты и любые другие технические средства. Все вышеперечисленные средства связи не разрешается приносить на территорию пункта проведения олимпиады.

Задания каждой возрастной параллели составляются в одном варианте, поэтому участники должны сидеть по одному за столом (партой). Во всех аудиториях, задействованных для проведения письменного тура, должны быть часы, поскольку выполнение заданий требует контроля за временем. В каждой аудитории должен быть компьютер и динамики (колонки) для прослушивания.

Для каждого участника необходимо подготовить распечатанный комплект заданий. Для выполнения заданий учащиеся обеспечиваются специальными бланками заданий

(см. Приложение 1), в которых размещены задания.

Участники должны быть обеспечены листами для черновиков. Черновики сдаются одновременно с бланками заданий, но черновики не проверяются жюри и не могут быть использованы в качестве доказательства при возможных апелляциях.

I am sitting at a desk in an immaculate stationary shop named Quill, attempting tomaster the letter M. 'I've got this,' I think with the false confidence of the beginner, as Idip my pen into the ink and drag the tip across the page. 'Wait,' says my teacher, Quillowner Lucy Edmonds. 'You are not holding your pen correctly. Loosen your grip.' I lookat my hand. I am unexpectedly tense, holding it like a caveman might have held a spear. Lucy tells me to stop treating it like a weapon but to regard it as my friend. 'Try again.' Imake a shape. Ink goes everywhere. 'Well done!' Lucy cries politely. The letter may beunidentifiable, but I feel wonderful.

I have always valued good handwriting. I spent three years of my childhood in the USA, where at school I was taught to write using D'Nealian manuscript form, an

ornatestyleofwritingthatlooksratherold-fashioned,andonethatIhavelongsinceabandonedin favour of general, neat handwriting. With my wedding coming up at the end of the year,and invitation letters to be sent out in the post, this seemed like the ideal time to polish mywriting skills. Eighty personalised envelopes to write by hand - does not sound too hard atask under normal circumstances. But modern calligraphy, I am learning, is a completely different animal.

I signed up for a modern calligraphy tutorial with Lucy, a 33-year-old who openedQuillfiveyearsago. Sheimpressesuponmetheneedtochangemymindset: withcalligraph y you are essentially drawing a letter rather than writing it. She gives me a dippen, which can create a finer line than any fountain pen. It is made up of a woodenpenholder into which you push a special, delicate tip. Preparing this is an art in itself - youcan pass it through a flame, which for me has the right amount of drama and ritual. Othersuse toothpaste. Then comes the hard bit: holding it correctly. You fingers should not curlroundtoomuchandyourthumbshouldnotcrossthem; thetiphastopointtothetopofthepaperat alltimes, withthe length of your peninline with yourarm.

I am later reassured by one of Quill's former tutors, Chiara Perano, who runs her owndesign studio, called Lamplighter, that I am not the only one who has struggled to masterthis most basic of skills. 'My job is essentially teaching grown-ups how to hold a pen.'Among them, she tells me, she has a number of primary school teachers trying to get somequalitytimeforthemselves. Theirreactionis, 'GoshIfeelsorryforthekidsnow.'Appreciating that it is harder than it looks, the teachers get an insight into what it feels liketolearnnormalhandwriting.

The appeal of modern calligraphy for many is that it looks attractive and requires afraction of the years that are needed to master the traditional art. Modern calligraphy isloosely based on the ornate cooperative style, but there are far fewer rules and you are encouraged to put your personality into it. With regular practice, you can write reasonably confidently in this style within six months. Which is, mercifully, as long as I have to getmyenvelopes right.
